Do you love wildlife? Do you want to volunteer for a rehabilitation centre that helps thousands of wild animals a year? BC SPCA Wild ARC is currently seeking volunteers to help develop and deliver wildlife education programs about wildlife welfare and cohabitation to adult audiences.

## Responsibilities

- Deliver Wild ARC educational presentations to various community groups, like senior centres, and local organizations and businesses
- Answer questions from public regarding Wild ARC and the practice of wildlife rehabilitation, as well as local species natural history, wildlife welfare, and cohabitation with wildlife
- Help develop and improve existing presentation materials and content

## Skills and experience required

- Demonstrated teaching experience or interest in skill development
- Comfortable speaking to groups and sharing information
- Friendly and engaging attitude
- No previous Wild ARC or wildlife knowledge is necessary, training will be provided

#### Time commitment

- This role is on-call, with events often scheduled during the day on weekdays, or in the evenings
- Volunteers should expect to be available for one presentation a month

## Requirements for the position

- 19 years or older (Students aged 16-18 may volunteer via school work experience program)
- Completion of online Volunteer Orientation
- Training shift shadowing a Senior Humane Education Presenter
