

Outreach Team Volunteer

Do you love wildlife? Do you want to volunteer for a rehabilitation centre that helps thousands of wild animals a year? BC SPCA Wild ARC is currently seeking volunteers to help educate the public about wildlife rehabilitation and the work of Wild ARC at markets, fairs, and other community outreach events.

Responsibilities

- Staff Wild ARC booth at community events
- Share information with members of the public about wildlife rehabilitation, Wild ARC, and the BC SPCA
- Assist with setup and take down of booth at outreach events, and occasionally pick up or drop off outreach supplies at Wild ARC
- Sell merchandise and process donations or sponsorships on behalf of Wild ARC

Skills and experience required

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Enjoy working with the public and sharing information
- Punctual and reliable
- No previous Wild ARC or wildlife knowledge is necessary, training will be provided

Time commitment

- This role is on-call, with events often scheduled during the day on weekends, or in the evenings
- Volunteer should expect to be available for one event a month

What we hope you will gain from your volunteer experience

- An opportunity to help wildlife by educating the public about Wild ARC
- An enhanced resume by adding experience gained in outreach and speaking with members of the public
- An increase in your knowledge of local wildlife species, natural history, and urban wildlife issues and welfare

Requirements for the position

- 19 years or older (Students aged 16-18 may volunteer via school work experience program)
- Completion of online Volunteer Orientation
- Training shift shadowing a Senior Outreach team member

Working Conditions**

- Work outside in a variety of weather conditions
- Walk on uneven ground (mulch, gravel, grass, pavement), and up/down low grade hills
- Sit or stand for two to four hour shift
- Occasionally lift 30 pounds - booth set up materials
