



Bird Window Decal

In Canada more than 25 million birds are injured or die from collisions with windows because they cannot see them. You can help reduce this by creating decals and placing them on your windows to help birds see the glass.

Materials:

Permanent markers (fine tip work best), transparency paper or film, scissors, and tape.

Directions:



Using a sheet of transparency paper draw a black outline using either one of the templates attached or your own creation.



Colour in your image and cut it out. The brighter the better!





Find a spot on a window and tape your decal up. Make sure to clean your window first.
