

EMERGENCY CHECKLIST

FOR FAMILIES WITH PETS

Every family member should be considered in emergency planning - including pets. It's important to have everything you need for your pets for 2-4 weeks.

- Food, water and treats for 2-4 weeks**
Dogs: 4 litres of water per day. Cats: 1 litre/day.
- Medications and medical records**
Include medications for 2-4 weeks, vet contact info, plus pet photos with written descriptions of your pets (stored in a Ziploc bag).
- Sturdy carriers for each pet**
- Waste supplies**
Waste bags for dogs. Cat litter box, litter, scoop, garbage bags for cats. Extra bedding, water bottle, hiding box, & hay for small animals.
- Towels and blankets**
- Toys to help entertain and lower stress**
Chew toys, balls, feather wands, food or treat dispensing puzzles & toys are all great choices.
- Record microchip, tattoo and license**
Store this information with their medical records.
- Get pet insurance**
Cover accidents & illnesses in emergency situations with Petsecure. Keep insurance info, account and contact info.
- Other supplies**
Dog leashes (6 foot and 15-20 foot), harness, muzzle. Consider having a cat harness and leash. Disinfectant for pet mess clean-up & paper towels.

PET FIRST AID KIT

- Exam Gloves**
- Penlight or Small Flashlight**
- Blunt Tip Scissors**
- Gauze pads & rolls**
- Rubbing Alcohol**
- Antibiotic Ointment**
- Sterile Rinse Solution**
- Cold Pack**
- Bandage Materials**
- Thermometer and Lubricating Jelly**
