Late this summer, the BC SPCA commissioned a public art installation to raise public awareness around the importance of spaying and neutering cats. The installation was then taken on the road throughout the Victoria area in September, showing up at various shopping mall parking lots to connect and engage with the local community. Volunteers from the BC SPCA Victoria branch as well as the Community Council were involved with this throughout the month of September. The installation, which is portable, is a massive wood box made to look like a cardboard box, and has "Free Kittens" painted on it. This would invite people to look inside where they would discover not kittens but facts about why it is so critical to spay or neuter. We got some surprised reactions! We found many people wanted to talk to us, whether rain or shine, and it generated some great conversations about cats and animal welfare overall.

It is very important to us at the Victoria BC SPCA that our next generation be given the opportunity to interact with and share their passion for animals. Our programs are built to encourage the innate empathy that are in our youth and to foster positive relationships.

In September, our presentation team offered all the schools in the Victoria, Sooke and Saanich districts half-price presentations, and teachers came out in force! Our staff and volunteers will be visiting schools throughout the fall, educating about empathy, dog safety, pet guardianship, community action, farm animal welfare, urban wildlife and social justice issues. Our programs at the shelter have begun again! The provincial holiday on October 20th will see 16 kids, between the ages of 8 and 11, learning all about dogs! From humane training, to breeds, to signals and more, our participants will finish the day with a broader knowledge of our canine friends. October 21st will kick off our first Service Saturday program for those ages 12 to 15! Participants will get a task of what it takes to be a volunteer, lending a hand with one volunteer activity, creating toys for the small animals and visiting out shelter animals!
