Cetacean Captivity Provision	S-203 An Act to amend the Criminal Code and other Acts (ending the captivity of whales and dolphins)	C-68 An Act to amend the Fisheries Act and other Acts in consequence
Prohibits taking cetaceans into captivity from the wild	yes	Yes (from within Canadian waters)
Prohibits the import or export of live cetaceans	Yes	No (subject to regulatory change)
Prohibits captive breeding of cetaceans	Yes	No
Prohibits the import or export of reproductive materials (sperm, embryo)	Yes	No (subject to regulatory change)
Permits captivity for care or rehabilitation of injured cetaceans	Yes	Yes
Grandparents existing cetacean captivity	Yes	N/A
