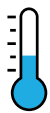

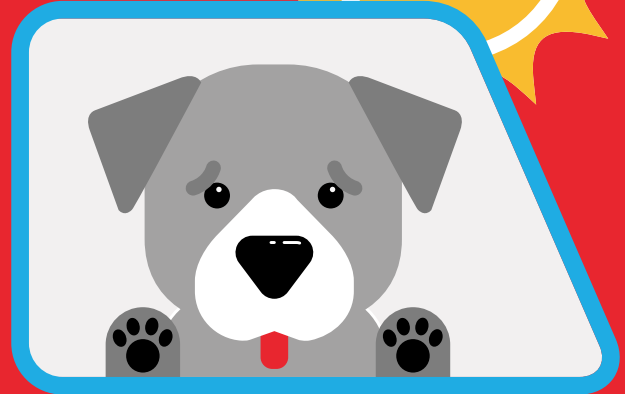


ALERT!

HEATSTROKE SIGNS

- Exaggerated panting
- Rapid or erratic pulse
- Salivation, anxious or staring expression
- Weakness and muscle tremors
- Convulsions or vomiting, and collapse

TREATMENT

- COOL DOWN: Wet animal with cool water
- DRINK: Provide cool drinking water
- NO ICE: Applying ice constricts blood flow
- FAN: Set up a cooling fan area
- VET: Take animal to vet for serious heat stroke
