Qualifications

- Minimum grade 12 education
- Post-secondary education (preferred)
- BC SPCA Introduction to Cruelty Investigations Course
- Passed both the Special Provincial Constable Exam and the Animal Protection Officer Exam
- Minimum of 3 Justice Institute Courses (or their equivalent)
 - IE 130 Introduction to investigative skills and processes **or**
 - IE 176 Introduction to Animal Cruelty Investigations;
 - IE 150 Report writing for Professional Investigators;
 - IE 160 Application and Execution of Search Warrants;
- Valid BC driver's license
- Posses basic computer skills sufficient to deal effectively with the necessary front office routines including a proficiency in BCSPCA Shelter Software
- Subject to a criminal records check
- Demonstrated knowledge of federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations regarding animals, animal welfare and related activities
- Demonstrated knowledge of animals, their breeds, characteristics and more common diseases
- Superior communication and organizational skills
- Additional considerations subject to approval by the GM of CI
- Must be approved by the Ministry of the Attorney General for appointment as a Special Provincial Constable under the Police Act
