### Wildlife Transport Team

Do you love wildlife? Do you want to volunteer for a rehabilitation centre that helps more than 3,000 animals a year? BC SPCA Wild ARC is currently seeking volunteers to transport safely-contained sick, injured, or orphaned wildlife to the centre for treatment. This role is vital to ensuring distressed animals get care as quickly as possible.

#### Skills and Experience:

- Dependable and committed to stated availability
- Strong communication skills
- Clean driving record, confident navigating the Greater Victoria area

#### Responsibilities:

- Pick up contained wild animals from the Greater Victoria area for transport to Wild ARC
- Ensure animals arrive safely and are transported in a low-stress manner (no pets, music, or loud conversation in vehicle)
- Provide basic information to members of the public as needed
- Ensure Wild ARC staff receive all accompanying paperwork where applicable

#### Time Commitment

- This role is an on-call position – volunteer can indicate their availability for potential transport assignments
- Volunteer must commit to a minimum of 1 transport per month for at least 6 months

#### Requirements for the Position

- 19 Years of age or older
- Orientation Session and Training Workshop
- Tetanus vaccine
- Valid BC driver's license; provision of 5 year ICBC driver's abstract
- Access to cell phone while on a transport assignment
