







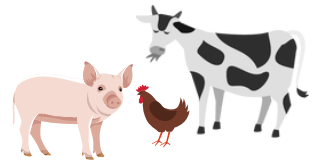
Farm Animal Match-Up

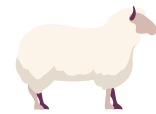
